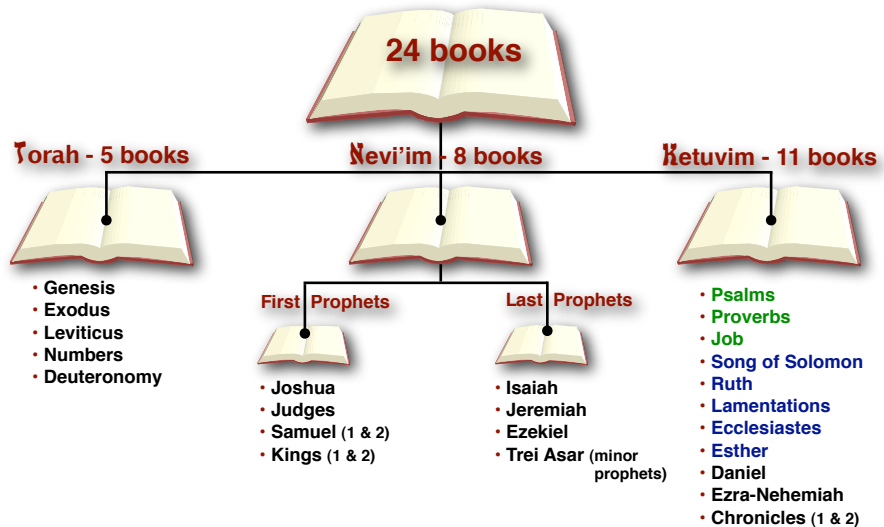
I. LOOKING BACK

- A. The Incarnation was God’s final and most complete self-disclosure (Heb. 1:1-4; John 14:9).
- B. Jesus “exegeted” the Father while on earth (John 1:18).
- C. We have been entrusted with the same task, to reveal the Father and His Kingdom to the world.

II. JESUS AND OUR OLD TESTAMENT

- A. Jesus’ Bible:
 1. Jesus accepted the three-fold division of the Jewish Bible:

THE TANAKH



- a. He referred to it specifically in his instruction of the eleven after his resurrection:

*Then he said to them, “These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the **Law** of Moses and the **Prophets** and the **Psalms** must be fulfilled.” — Luke 24:44.*

NOTES

- b. He alluded to two of the three divisions in a debate with the scribes and Pharisees (Abel is in Genesis and Zechariah in 2 Chronicles):

Therefore I send you prophets and wise men and scribes, some of whom you will kill and crucify, and some you will flog in your synagogues and persecute from town to town, so that on you may come all the righteous blood shed on earth, from the blood of innocent Abel to the blood of Zechariah the son of Barachiah, whom you murdered between the sanctuary and the altar. — Matthew 23:34, 35.

B. Jesus' Use of the Tanakh

1. Jesus mentioned *at least* sixteen individuals from the Old Testament by name in his teaching.

2. Those he mentioned also cover the entire range of the Tanakh (Genesis to 2 Chronicles):
3. Jesus *quoted* extensively from the Tanakh:
 - a. Matthew attributes 45 of his 61 quotations from the OT to Jesus.
 - (1) Jesus quotes from 19 of the 39 books!
 - (2) Jesus quotes from all five Books of Law
 - (3) Jesus quotes from all four of the Major Prophets.
 - (4) Jesus quotes from 2 of the 5 Books of Poetry (Psalms, Proverbs)
 - (5) Jesus quotes from 8 of the 12 Minor Prophets.
 - b. Mark attributes 28 of his 35 quotations from the OT to Jesus.
 - (1) Jesus quotes from 11 of the 39 books!
 - (2) Jesus quotes from 4 Books of Law (exc. Numbers)
 - (3) Jesus quotes from all four of the Major Prophets.
 - (4) Jesus quotes from 1 of the 5 Books of Poetry (Psalms)
 - (5) Jesus quotes from 2 of the 12 Minor Prophets (Joel, Zechariah)
 - c. Luke attributes 23 of his 38 quotations from the OT to Jesus.
 - (1) Jesus quotes from 10 of the 39 books!
 - (2) Jesus quotes from 3 Books of Law (Exodus, Leviticus, Deut.)
 - (3) Jesus quotes from all four of the Major Prophets.
 - (4) Jesus quotes from 1 of the 5 Books of Poetry (Psalms)
 - (5) Jesus quotes from 2 of the 12 Minor Prophets (Hosea, Malachi)
 - d. John attributes 4 of his 14 quotations from the OT to Jesus.
 - (1) Jesus quotes from 3 of the 39 books!
 - (2) Jesus does not quote from the Books of Law.
 - (3) Jesus quotes from 2 of the four Major Prophets (Isaiah, Jeremiah)
 - (4) Jesus quotes from 1 of the 5 Books of Poetry (Psalms)
 - (5) Jesus does not quote from any of the 12 Minor Prophets.
4. Jesus made extensive reference to Old Testament people, places and events in his teaching throughout his entire ministry.
5. He *assumed* familiarity with Jewish history on the part of his listeners.
6. Jesus made reference to their past at least nineteen times in his teaching:

C. Jesus’ Perspective on the Tanakh

1. Jesus believed and repeatedly taught that the Hebrew Bible’s main subject matter was Him!

a. He intimated it to his disciples early on:

And taking the twelve, he said to them, “See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written about the Son of Man by the prophets will be accomplished.” — Luke 18:31

b. He said it clearly to the Pharisees near the end of his ministry:

“You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me,...Do not think that I will accuse you before the Father; the one who accuses you is Moses, in whom you have set your hope.” — John 5:39, 45

c. He said it clearly to his disciples *after* his resurrection:

“...Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?” And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself. — Luke 24:26, 27

D. Twelve Words – One Story” – A Old Testament Outline

1. The history of God’s people can be summarized using 12 words arranged in three groups of four letters:

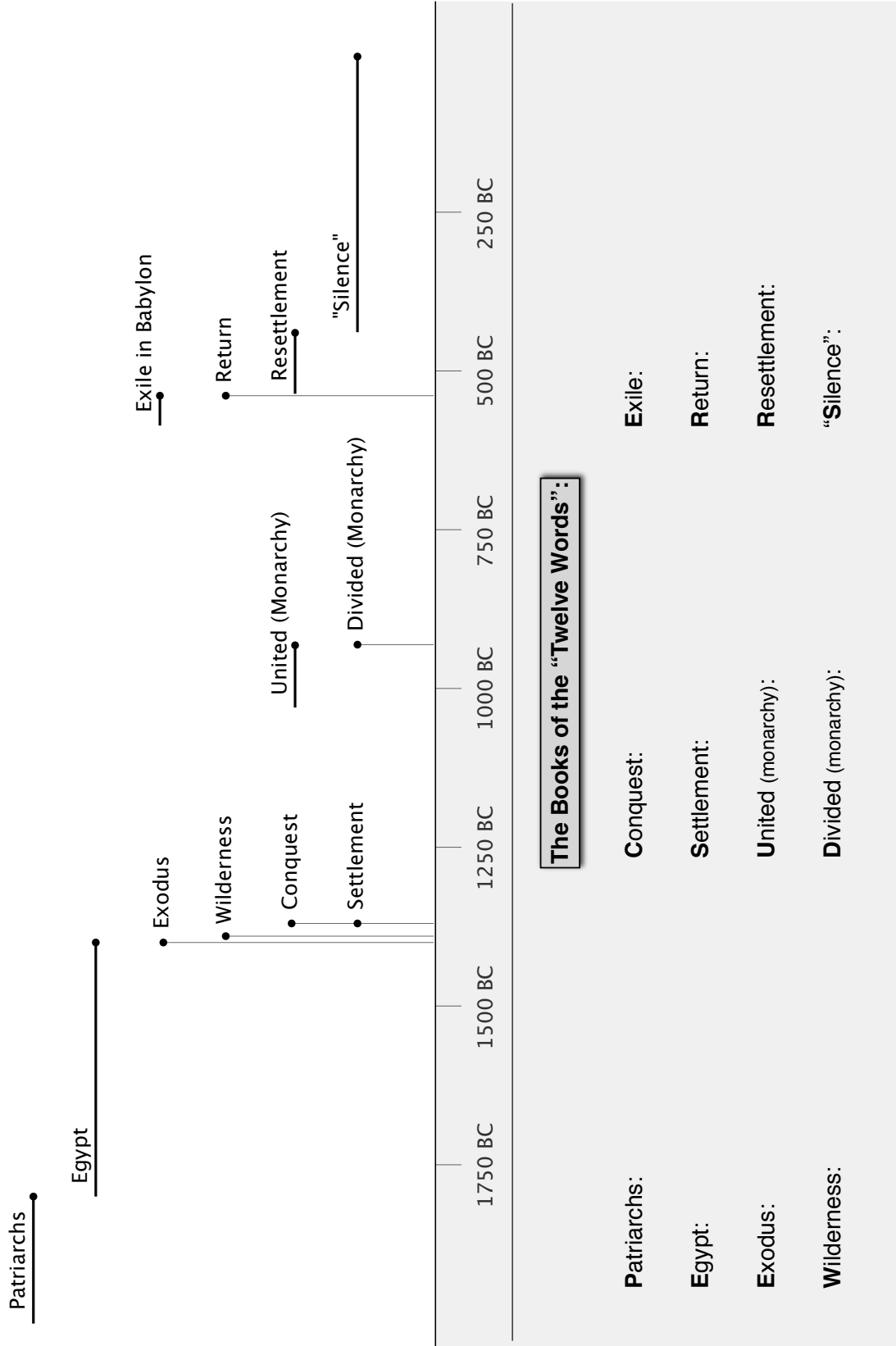

E. Our “Old, Old Story” Isn’t Old Enough!

1. Three honest errors:

- a. We assume that because the OT is Hebrew story about the Jews that it is a “Jewish” book.
- b. Because Jews accept the Tanakh and reject the NT, we assume that the NT is the “Christian” book.
- c. Because Jesus is the *centerpiece* of the Gospel, we assume that him as “the first and the last” (Rev. 1:18; 22:13-16) means the “old, old story” begins with Jesus.
- d. Jesus tells us that he *is* the “hermeneutical key” to the Bible, but that the “old, old story” began much before Bethlehem (cf. John 5:39,45; 8:56; Luke 24:27,44; Matt. 5:17).

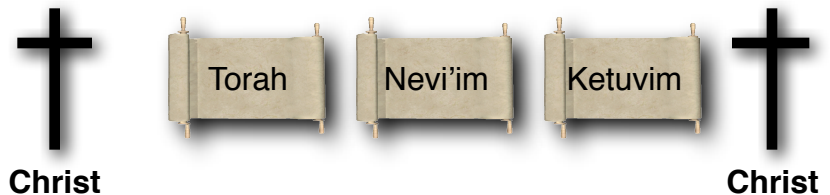
2. Jesus tells us to study the Old Testament in light of what we now know about him and the Gospel:

And he said to them, “O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?” And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself. — Luke 24:25-27.

- a. This gives the “big picture,” creating one book with one story broken into two “movements.”
- b. This provides us with a clearer sense of the purpose and direction of the Old Testament story.
- c. This provides a “prophetic context” for the person and work of Jesus Christ (i.e. the scope of his fulfillment).
- d. It causes us to see ourselves in the same “old, old story” as King David, not merely Paul:

“Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see my day. He saw it and was glad.” — John 8:56.

“And if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s offspring, heirs according to promise.” — Galatians 3:29.
